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## **Aquarelle Lip Tattooing Information Sheet**

Q. Where are you based?

A. The address is: Woodlawn, Beacon Hill Road, Hindhead, Surrey, GU26 6QB.

Q. How much does Lip tattooing cost?

A. Lip treatment costs £450. A deposit of £50 is needed to secure any appointment, which is then deducted from the remaining balance of your treatment fee. I don't take cards, so unless you're paying by cash on the day, please arrange a bank transfer, which must reach me before your treatment can go ahead. BACS details are further down this page.

Q. Is there a consultation fee?

A. The consultation fee is £50 and is taken off your treatment fee, should you decide to go ahead. During a consultation, I do the patch test and discuss treatment options and suitability for treatment. This is a half hour appointment and must be secured with the consultation fee.

Q. How long does the procedure take?

A. The consultation is half an hour and the initial treatment session is between 2 - 4 hours.

Q. How long does it last?

A. The result can last between a year and 4 years, depending on the depth of pigment colour used.

Q. If I decide to stop having treatment, over time will the tattoo completely disappear?

A. You may always have a very faint trace of the tattoo if you stop having treatments.

Q. Do I need to come for a consultation/patch test?

A. It is essential to have a patch test for lip treatment. Treatment cannot take place for at least 24 hours after performing the test.

Q. What if I need to cancel my appointment?

A. You must cancel at least 48 hours before your appointment date, or you will lose your £50 deposit. I will reschedule your appointment and keep the deposit until you come in for the new appointment date, then it will be deducted from your remaining balance.

Q. How long does it take to heal and is there scabbing?

A. It takes about a week to heal and there can be significant scabbing, giving a very chapped appearance to the lips until healed and sometimes as much as 50% of the pigment is lost. Occasionally a client will continue to lose pigment however, which is down to the way an individual heals, so further sessions may be needed.

Q. Will my lips be swollen after treatment?

A. There can be significant swelling and soreness for 48 hours after the procedure. I suggest taking a "One a day" antihistamine for a few days prior to treatment and about 5 days post treatment. Some clients have only a little swelling and/or soreness. This is all dependent upon the individual.

Q. Can I have lip tattooing if I get cold sores?

A. Yes, it's possible to treat you, as long as you take prescribed oral antiviral medication for at least 5 days before the procedure and a week post the procedure. This is not a guarantee however, that you will not develop a cold sore and that this could result in a loss of pigment in the area.

Q. I've been diagnosed with Haemangioma on my lip. Can I have Lip Tattooing?

A. I'm afraid it's not possible to tattoo anyone who has this condition. In fact any vascular conditions in the treatment area, like varicose veins for example, are a contraindication for Lip tattooing.

Q. Can I do exercise immediately after the treatment?

A. Exercise is fine following treatment, however, no swimming, saunas, steam rooms etc, until your lips have healed.

Q. When can I go in the sun after treatment?

A. You can go in the sun 1 week - 10 days after treatment, but please protect your lips from sun exposure, by wearing a strong sun block.

Q. Can I have Botox just before, or after treatment?

A. If the Botox is near the area being tattooed, you must wait for a month after having Botox before you can have lip tattooing and you must wait for at least 2 weeks after lip tattooing before you can have Botox .

Q. Can I have lip fillers?

A. You must wait a month after you've had lip fillers before I can treat you and 2 weeks after lip tattooing before you can have lip fillers.

Q. Will it be very dark until healed?

A. The colour can start off very strong, depending on the desired effect, like wearing a lipstick, but will soften a lot during healing, creating more on a tint.

Q. Is this treatment for all ethnicities and skin and hair tones?

A. Not always. For instance, if you are dark skinned and have a dark vermilion border to your

lips and a pinkish colour on other areas of your lips, it can create a very noticeable difference in colour once healed, creating a patchy 2 toned effect. I can assess your suitability during the consultation, or with a good, makeup free photo.

Q. Can I have the treatment if I'm pregnant, or breastfeeding?

A. No, you must wait until after the baby is born and breastfeeding has finished.

Q. Can I have the treatment if I'm undergoing Chemo?

A. You have to be at least 5 weeks clear of chemo and in some situations, a letter of consent may be asked for.

Q. I have a health condition. Can I have this treatment done?

A. If you have a health condition and/or are taking medication, this must be discussed with me directly, before we can proceed, to make sure there are no contraindications.

Q. I'm under 18 years old. Can I have the treatment?

A. In some circumstances, this can be done as long as there is consent from a parent or guardian, plus written permission from your doctor and that my insurance company is happy for us to proceed.

Q. I'm in my 70's. Can I have this done?

A. As long as you're healthy and depending on your skin texture, you can have this treatment at any age.
