Aquarelle lips, Eyeliner and Ombre Brow Aftercare instructions

These treatments are DRY HEALED. No ointments, moisturisers or creams are to go onto the treated areas.

Try not to get the area wet, but if you do, pat dry straight away with a tissue. The normal healing period is between 4 and 7 days. You will get some scabbing but do not pick these areas off prematurely as you may lose pigment underneath. Once healed you can resume your normal facial cleansing regime and go back to your usual moisturiser. A good sun block is a must once healed, to ensure your brows, lips and eyeliner doesn't fade due to UV exposure!

Should you need a follow up session to make any corrections, this should be taken within 3 months of your initial session which will be free of charge. After this time, normal top up charges will apply.

During the post-treatment period, please try to avoid:

- . Applying any makeup to the treated areas.
- . Getting the treated area wet while showering/bathing.
- . Sunbathing, using sun beds, or swimming.
- . Facial treatments, including eyelash extensions, eyebrow tinting, plucking, electrolysis etc.
- . Using any form of depilatory products.
- . Do not pick any areas of scabbing.

It is vital that you keep the treated areas clean to avoid infection. If infection does occur, don't worry, but if necessary, seek medical attention.

Please note that there could be as much as a 20 – 40% loss of pigment once healed and possible patchiness. A little scabbing is normal, so please don't worry and most importantly, please don't pick at the healing area, as this can result in an uneven healed result.

The aftercare procedures have been explained to me in full and I have read the instructions given on this sheet. I have also been given a copy of these instructions to keep for reference.
